A. Program & Financial Update – Summer 2011

Staff is in the process of preparing for summer programs by putting front-line staff in place, ordering supplies and getting facilities ready. The Aquatic Facility will open on Saturday, June 4 and camps begin on Monday, June 13. Staff provided updated revenues and enrollment numbers through May 20 for summer recreation programs, beach, pool, and fitness center.

<u>Camp:</u> Overall camps are similar to last year. Several camps have been changed to 2-week sessions from 4-week sessions. The new Elite camp has 18 registered – may open a second session.

Recreation: Tee ball registration is low but program doesn't begin until July with most participants signing up at the last minute. Girls softball numbers are down – the program combined with Lake Forest, Lincolnshire, and Highland Park

<u>Tennis:</u> First year for in house tennis programs; junior tennis is off to a great start. Any rain cancellations are being held in the gym. A women's Lakeshore D team was formed.

Pool: Early bird pricing will be extended until May 31. Pool concession items have been enhanced. Special events have been planned throughout the summer. Swim clubs are renting additional hours on the weekends in the early morning. The pool will be open on Thursday and Friday between the hours of 555:00pm-6:30pm.

<u>Fitness Center:</u> Memberships are approximately the same as last year; however, more Individual Plus Classes memberships have been sold.
