Time and Attendance Software – Time Clocks Plus - Approval

Executive Director Salski outlined the Request for Proposal and the costs presented by three companies. Executive Director Salski mentioned Time Clocks Plus was the preferred choice. Employees will use a biometrics clock and the Park District is anticipated to save 5-8% in payroll costs each year. Commissioner Ehrhard asked if the savings will pay back the software. Executive Director Salski stated the savings will provide some savings during its life span.

Executive Director Salski outlined specific modules will assist staff becoming more efficient and allow the Park District to track benefits and budget more easily. Executive Director Salski outlined the project is anticipated to be under budget.

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Vice-President Douglass moved, seconded by Commissioner Gordon, to authorize the Executive Director with Attorney approval to enter into an agreement with Time Clock Plus purchasing time clocks and corresponding software, training and warranties and other costs detailed in the proposal not to exceed \$45,994.
